Most studies of achievement regarding charter schools compares average achievement in charters to that in traditional public schools. We focuses on achievement gaps *within* charter schools, asking whether gaps in early grades narrow over time. Using longitudinal data on multiple cohorts from 2006 to 2021 in Missouri, we examine how test score gaps in math, reading, and science observed in 3rd grade change over the next five years.
